



Contact Lens Fees and Policies

Contact lens fittings are not part of a standard annual eye exam and are not covered by most insurance plans. The prices below are just a quote. Final cost of the fitting will be determined by the doctor after the initial examination.

Contact Lens Fees:

Note: All **new contact lens wearers** must complete the insert and removal training to ensure proper handling.

The training fee is in addition to the fitting fee.

Spherical Contacts	\$70
Toric Contacts	\$80
Multifocal Contacts	\$120
Custom/Specialty Contacts	\$250 & Up
Insert and Removal Training	\$60

Contact Lens Exam Includes:

- Contact Lens Fitting
- Retinal Imaging
- Trial Lenses
- Contact Lens Kit
- Follow up visits up to 30 days

Contact lens prescriptions must be finalized within 30 days to avoid additional fees.

Your contact lens prescription is valid for two years after your final prescription has been determined.

Contact Lens Disclosure:

As with any drug or device, the use of daily wear or extended wear contact lens is not without risk. A small percentage of individuals develop potentially serious complications that can lead to permanent eye damage. If you have any unexplained pain, redness, watery eyes, discharge, cloudy, foggy, or decrease in vision or increased sensitivity to light, remove your contact lenses and seek professional care. Arrangements should be made to see your eye care professional before wearing your contact lenses again.
